We merged with another local primary school in September 2022 and are proud to have opened a 2 year old provision, extensive family and adult learning with a children's centre and community hub development later this year. Rhyl is a unique school in Camden and leads the way as a school serving the community with extensive wrap around services. It is a very exciting time to join our school as we continue to expand and develop.

We have a high number of disadvantaged and vulnerable children and families and an exceptionally high number of children with wide ranging Special Educational Needs and are strongly committed to inclusion for everyone. Rhyl is recognised as providing excellent inclusive provision for children with complex needs and this is due to our highly skilled and committed staff. We want our pupils to have the highest aspirations and the highest achievement possible. Our children are well-motivated, enthusiastic and eager to learn. We have developed an exciting cross-curricular and creative curriculum which provides meaningful learning experiences for all of our children.

We have an award-winning kitchen garden and teaching kitchen and work closely with the Jamie Oliver Food Foundation to promote growing and cooking within the curriculum as well as with Giorgio Locatelli and the Ritz who have adopted the school and run workshops with the children. Music is integral to all that we do and we have won many awards as well as having close partnerships with the London Symphony Orchestra and the Barbican. Literacy and reading are the foundation of our curriculum which is a theme based approach and provides dedicated opportunities for children to learn through the expressive arts as well as through regular visits to London venues.

We are looking for someone who can increase parental involvement in our family learning programme and who will be able to broker additional support for the school and our community to enhance our provision.

This post involves working closely with staff as well as parents and you will need to be both creative and adaptable and able to work confidently with a range of different professionals and people.

- The ability to act as advocate, mediator and negotiator for our parents and carers in a range of situations
- Significant experience of working with and engaging parents/carers and children through individual and/or group-based support
- The ability to develop and deliver a range of family learning opportunities to support parents/carers to engage more fully in their child's learning and to reintegrate parents into work or study
- An understanding of how to promote good school attendance and punctuality and how to tackle poor attendance (Including persistent absence or exclusion)
- Drive, enthusiasm, resilience and positive attitudes
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills
- Strong partnership skills, including ability to work professionally and confidently in close liaison with schools and other agencies
