School Context

Smitham is a large, over-subscribed primary school in Coulsdon, Surrey. It expanded to 3FE in Sept. 2019 and is currently 3FE in Yrs R-4 and 2FE in Yrs 5&6. Due to popular demand a second Nursery class was opened in Sept. 2022.

The expansion provided a catalyst for development. We effectively articulated our vision for being a LEARNING COMMUNITY, supporting our community and delivering a broad, balanced and ambitious curriculum for all our learners.

Our outstanding provision, both indoor and out, enriches the learning with a dedicated Art and Science workshop, music studio, ipad trolleys in every year group, two libraries, two halls, pond, amphitheatre, orchard/meadow and a large woodland area, in which every child learns through our Forest Schools programme. The large field, re-surfaced cage, climbing apparatus, construction hut and reading chalet ensure the children have 'happy and safe' play and lunch times. This provision also enables us to run a comprehensive programme of extracurricular activities.

We are a diverse community with numbers of PP, EAL and SEND children roughly in line or just below national. We know our children and their families well; our open door policy ensures we work in partnership with all stakeholders.

We are committed to ensuring everyone in our community is a learner; all children and staff are supported and challenged to reach their full potential. Our data, at all key stages in all areas, is inline or above the national expectations.

We value stakeholder voice through Parent and Senior Leadership Forums, our seven pupil councils and our staff Well-being Forums. Each group has effected change within the school. Our approach to designing our bespoke Curriculum has empowered our staff and helped to foster a culture embedded in research and professional dialogue.

Our governing body are an integral part of our community, overseeing the development of the school, whilst providing effective support and challenge.

Our very active PTA achieve the right balance between fund-raising and community events. They also support our efforts to be eco-friendly.

Smitham is a wonderfully inspiring and nurturing school, with a very strong, supportive community.
