Information about Holy Cross Preparatory School

The school, which was founded by the Sisters of the Holy Cross in 1926 and moved to the present site in 1971, is located in an historic house with large grounds, including netball and tennis courts and a sports field, in a conservation area on Kingston Hill in south-west London. In 2009 the completion of a major building project created new sports, performing arts and classroom areas, with new dining facilities and kitchen.

The school is owned by the Trustees of the Sisters of the Holy Cross. The Trustees, together with the Advisory Body, are responsible for the governance of the school.

The school has two forms in each year, with 290 pupils currently on roll. The school automatically offers places to Catholic girls and siblings of current pupils; otherwise the admission procedure consists of an introductory session for the four year old pupils or a day's visit for older pupils. The ability of the pupils is above the national average and most pupils are of average or above average ability as assessed by nationally standardised measures. Pupils come from mainly professional and business families, many (currently 48%), but not all, of the Catholic faith, and from a wide range of other ethnic and cultural backgrounds. Although the school is a Catholic foundation it welcomes pupils of other faiths.

Holy Cross Prep has very high standards in all areas. The School is extremely proud of its academic achievements but celebrates equally its friendly, nurturing and caring ethos. In the November 2013 Sunday Times Parent Power feature, Holy Cross Preparatory School was named as the Prep School of the Year and came 2nd in their ranking of schools based on performance in tests for 11 year olds. The School came 5th in the same list in November 2014.

Inspection Reports

In June 2016 an inspection was carried out by the Independent Schools Inspectorate (ISI) and their report is available to read or download on the Schools website. This inspection was one of a new format in which the inspection team examine 8 broad areas of the school for regulatory compliance.

Unlike the previous framework of Integrated Inspections which included qualitative judgements e.g. outstanding, good etc., the Compliance Inspection is assessed as either 'met' or 'not met'.

We are delighted that Holy Cross met all the ISI Standards and that no further action is required.

Prior to that in June 2010 Holy Cross Preparatory School was inspected by the Independent Schools Inspectorate (ISI) and received an outstanding report. There were many major strengths listed and no significant weaknesses. The report can also be found on our website.
