Invigilators are expected to approach the job in a serious and professional manner with emphasis on punctuality and reliability. They should also have the ability to communicate effectively with people.

The role is a casual contract, so hours and days will vary dependent on operational need, however availability between the hours of 8.30am and 3.30pm is required.
