THE SIXTH FORM

The great majority of our Year 11 students choose to progress to our outstanding Sixth Form where they are joined by a significant number of high achieving students from other schools, who also recognise our expertise and excellence in Post 16 provision. The Sixth Form is very much at the heart of our school, both physically and spiritually, as our Sixth Form students provide additional first class leadership to students lower down the school.

As well as a wide range of A level courses (with a 3 year average pass rate of 99.5%, the vast majority at grades A*, A or B) we offer our Sixth Form students a wealth of enrichment activities which help them demonstrate a wide range of skills and attributes that are highly desirable to both universities and employers.

When our Sixth Formers move on from us they are able to pick and choose between the best universities, courses and employment opportunities available to them. We believe firmly in the benefits of being an 11-18 school and taking our students all the way through their secondary education until they are ready to thrive in the next stages of their lives.
