Our beautiful, light and airy art studios are home to our Art and Design Department. A lively, creative hub, pupils have the opportunity to develop their skills, express their creative ideas and explore a wide range of materials and techniques.

At Clifton High we cover the formal elements of art and design which include drawing, painting, mixed media, printmaking, sculpture, ceramics, ICT and photography. The study of art history and art appreciation are also important elements of our curriculum.

Boys and girls in Years 7-9 receive one double lesson (one hour and forty minutes) per fortnight and we encourage all our pupils to become successful, confident young artists whatever their age or ability. We also offer Art at GCSE and A level.
