Formby High School is a heavily oversubscribed 11-18 mixed comprehensive academy with 1,100 students (including over 230 in sixth form). The school's motto 'determined to achieve' is central to our vision for all aspects of school life, in and out of the classroom, and across the community. The school employs over 140 dedicated and highly effective teaching and support staff who work closely with parents to achieve the best possible outcomes for our students. Formby High School was judged to be Good across all areas in the most recent Ofsted inspection (November 2022).
