



FIVE FASCINATING FACTS ABOUT MOSCOW

MOSCOW'S METRO SYSTEM



Moscow boasts one of the world's most extensive and beautiful metro systems, known for its stunning architecture, intricate mosaics, and ornate chandeliers. Some stations, like Komsomolskaya and Mayakovskaya, resemble underground palaces, reflecting the Soviet era's grandeur and artistic vision.

THE KREMLIN



At the heart of Moscow lies the iconic Kremlin, a fortified complex that serves as the official residence of the President of Russia. It encompasses several palaces, cathedrals, and historic buildings, including the Grand Kremlin Palace and the Assumption Cathedral, which are prime examples of Russian architecture and history.

RED SQUARE



Red Square, a UNESCO World
Heritage Site, is one of Moscow's
most famous landmarks,
renowned for its historical and
cultural significance. It has been
a focal point for major events
throughout Russian history,
including military parades, political
demonstrations, and public
celebrations. St. Basil's Cathedral,
with its colourful onion domes,
is a striking architectural gem
located at one end of the square.

THE BOLSHOI THEATRE

RUSSIAN COSMONAUTICS MUSEUM

The Cosmonautics Museum, located in the northern part of the city, houses an extensive collection of artifacts, spacecraft models, and memorabilia related to Russia's achievements in space exploration. Visitors can learn about the groundbreaking missions of Yuri Gagarin, the first human to journey into outer space, and other significant milestones in space exploration achieved by Russian cosmonauts.
