In recent years we have broadened our sporting curriculum by offering boys' hockey, as well as encouraging pupils to participate in school squash, badminton and golf teams.

The department is fortunate in the time that it has allocated to the subject and the number of specialist and enthusiastic members of staff (full-time and part-time), who devote much time and effort to providing opportunities for the pupils.

### **Job Description – PE / Games Teacher (Maternity Cover)**

- To teach Academic PE at GCSE and up to A level. An ability to teach physiology and biomechanics is desirable.
- For a candidate with suitable skills and experience, to be Head of Netball: responsible for netball throughout the school including staffing, fixtures, transport, refreshments etc.
- To assist in the coaching of the major games throughout the school.
- To plan and prepare all lessons to be taught, as specified on the departmental timetable.
- To follow schemes of work as laid down by the department, and where relevant suggest ways of improvement.
- To be responsible for the general appearance of facilities / storerooms / changing rooms.
- To attend departmental meetings and INSET courses as agreed with the Head of Department.
- To be aware of pupils' disabilities or medical conditions, needs and strengths.
- To be responsible for school teams at school fixtures: Home umpire / judge, host visiting members of staff
   Away travel with team, umpire or judge accordingly.
- To run extra-curricular clubs.
- To be available on weekends and after school when required.
