



Instrumental Music Teacher

The successful applicant will be:

- Qualified (with a degree in music and / or education) and / or have extensive teaching experience working in a school environment
- Enthusiastic and have skills to inspire and nurture the musical talents of young motivated students
- Skilled to teach in a variety of different musical styles including classical, contemporary and musical theatre
- Able to demonstrate an ability to lead large school choirs of developing voices and smaller chamber choirs
- Literate with technology, show initiative, be organised and accountable
- Willing to connect, contribute and work as part of a team of music teacher

Both positions will commence in Term 1, 2020 and the ability to teach music theory and any other musical instrument would be an advantage

The program at each school is administered fully by school staff who support all teachers and ensure continued growth, while allowing individual teachers the freedom to facilitate lessons based on their area of expertise. Tuition fees are collected by the school and the successful applicant will be guided by the conditions outlined in a formal agreement and position description. Performances, meetings, reporting, extra-curricular activities and involvement with school ensembles is required. Knowledge of, and a willingness to prepare students for external music examinations is also required (AMEB and / or Trinity). The school has modern, well resourced, air-conditioned teaching studios and all students are taught as individuals or in pairs during school hours and before or after school.

The successful applicant will need to hold a current QLD Working with Children Blue Card (or have current QLD teacher registration), an ABN, Public Liability Insurance and comply with various Brisbane Catholic Education policies (including Child Protection and Code of Conduct). The latter requires the completion of online training modules after appointment.
