Job Purpose

- To contribute to all aspects of the musical life of the College
- To work with individual students and to encourage their development

Reporting to: Director of Music

Key Responsibilities

- Contribute to the running of liturgical music in the College and at St Peter's Church.
 - engage fully in assisting the Director of Music and Organist in leading the musical elements of liturgy in the College and at St Peter's
 - play the organ for the majority of services (both choral and non-choral) at St Peter's
 - assist in the recruitment of choristers
 - assist in training the Choir of St Peter's Church, ensuring the highest possible musical standards
 - $\circ\;$ share in the piano accompaniment of examination candidates and concert soloists
- Contribute to the wider musical life of the College.
 - o assist as a staff member at major concerts
 - work with the Director of Music and Organist to devise and lead outreach activities and liaison with local schools, ensembles and organisations
- Support the running of a boarding house.
 - o residing in the boarding house during term-time
 - work with the Pastoral Head (the Stonyhurst term for Housemaster/Housemistress) on duties associated with boarding pastoral care
 - to work up to a maximum of three evenings per week on boarding duty
