



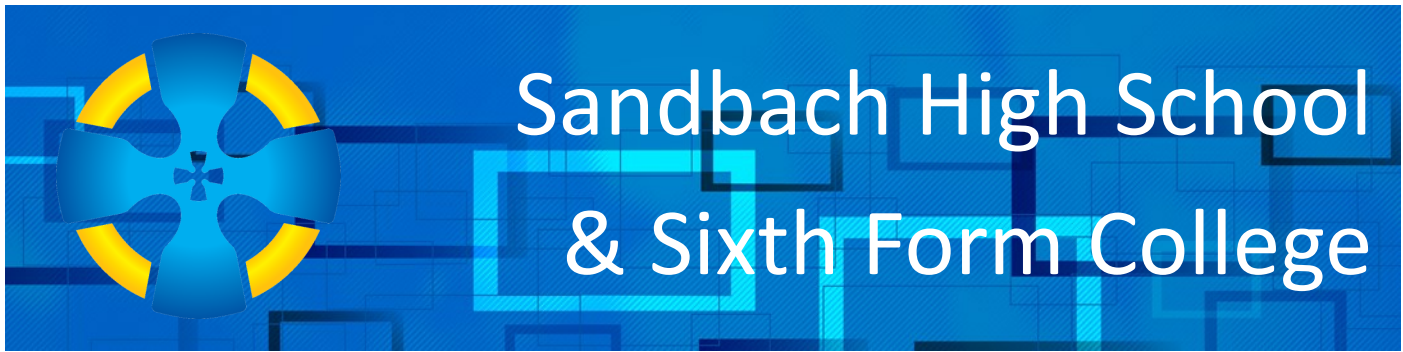

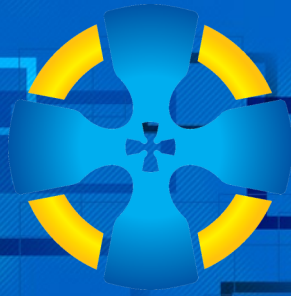

Curriculum


Sociology and Psychology both follow the AQA specifications with currently 58 learners studying 'A' level Sociology across Year 1 and Year 2 and 85 learners studying 'A' level Psychology across Year 1 and Year 2.

Timetable

We run a two week timetable of five, one hour lessons each day.

At KS5, students have 10 hours per subject per fortnight, taught by two teachers.
