Construction of our new Lincolnshire campus is underway. The first phase opened in September 2015 and includes new state-of-the-art specialist teaching accommodation including classrooms, science labs, and animal management facility; agriculture, engineering and arboriculture workshops; a learning resources centre; refectory and facilities for administration, student services and staff. The second phase is due for completion in summer 2016 and will provide the campus with a Sports & Fitness Centre and a Health & Nutrition Centre. The third phase is now being planned.

You will be an energetic and reliable causal animal technician, assisting in the efficient operation of the Animal Management facilities. You will also ensure a high standard of animal welfare.

Duties will include the general husbandry of a wide variety of species including rodents, reptiles, primates and other small mammals and will involve working at both Riseholme and Bishop Burton campuses. This position is a fixed term contract and will involve weekend and Bank holiday working.

You must hold a Level 3 Animal Care qualification, or equivalent, or working towards this. You will also have good knowledge of general animal husbandry with previous experience within an animal establishment.
