Thank you for your interest in the position of Head of Humanities at The Beaulieu Park School. As Essex's only 'all through' school, our school is truly unique. Following a £34 million build, we are delighted to have an environment in which to deliver a truly all through and outstanding education for our students. As Head of Humanities, your role will be pivotal in the creation of a school that has the highest standards and aspirations for all students, regardless of their background or ability.

This appointment is critical to the future success of the school. The successful candidate will be a key player in our close-knit, founding team and work closely with all stakeholders to realise the outstanding potential that exists when a school is created from the ground up. Your experiences at The Beaulieu Park School will develop your leadership skills and give you an excellent experience to prepare you for a senior leadership role if that is your aim.

As the Head of Humanities and first Humanities teacher at the school, the successful candidate will be responsible for designing the curriculum and teaching our first group of Year 7 students across History, Geography and R.E.. There are eight hours of Humanities teaching assigned to Year 7 over two weeks. It is envisaged that Humanities will be delivered as 3 x History, 3 x Geography and 2 x R.E. lessons over the fortnight, however the successful candidate may prefer a different model which would be considered.

As the school grows, additional members of staff will be added to the department accordingly. In year 3, when our first cohort reach KS4, the TLR offered for this post will increase to TLR1B.

The Principal and Governors are open-minded regarding the professional profile of potential applicants. Whilst not suitable for an NQT, this post may be suitable for someone that is relatively new to the profession, or indeed for a more experienced colleague. What is crucial is that the successful candidate has the skills, drive, energy and ambition to make Humanities here at Beaulieu Park a real beacon of success.
