Job Description Lead Teacher of Maths

This postholder is responsible for leading and managing the Maths department and teaching Maths to KS3 and GCSE pupils in the first instance. As our school grows they will also teach Maths to AS and A2 students. The role includes planning, teaching and assessing the subject to ensure that pupils at all starting points make outstanding progress. The aim is for the postholder to grow their career as the school grows and more teachers are appointed. The postholder will be fully committed to the 3-18 through-school ethos.

Key responsibilities

- Lead on the teaching and learning of Maths in our secondary section
- Develop our Key Stage 3, GSSE and A Level curriculum and resources
- Liaise closely with the primary faculty leaders and faculty teams
- Ensure excellent primary/secondary transition in their subject
- Monitor pupil progress, ensuring secure teacher assessments inform pupil grouping and interventions effectively
- Ensure that reporting is timely, accurate and effective
