Our Schools

We are a small Trust currently comprising two schools, with our third school proposed to open in September 2027/28.



Wootton Park School opened in 2016 with just two Reception and four Year 7 classes. In September 2022, we had our first Year 6 and Year 13 cohorts and are now operational in every year group from Reception to Year 13. In 2020, we moved into our brand-new £20 million state-of-the-art school building at Wootton Hall Park.

WPS offers its learners a first-rate and unique learning environment, ensuring high levels of academic achievement and personal development for all while promoting community participation and building a stronger society.

Both Ofsted inspections, in July 2019 and March 2025, rated WPS as 'Outstanding' in all areas.

The school has received multiple accolades at the Northamptonshire Education Awards, including Overall School of the Year (2023), Secondary School of the Year (2023) and Primary School of the Year (2022).
