FROM THE HEADTEACHER

Thank you for taking the time to find out more about working at North Bromsgrove High School. The school serves the Bromsgrove community and currently has 800 students on roll. It is fair to say that the school has faced significant challenge in the last few years and that the recent OFSTED grading (May 18) placed the school in 'Special Measures'. Following the inspection two interim headteachers were seconded into North Bromsgrove High School to support the future development of this vibrant community school moving forward.

We encourage you to read the OFSTED report which describes a school with failing leadership, poor outcomes and poor behaviour. Once you have read the report we recommend that you come and visit North Bromsgrove High School because what you will see will not match what you have read. North Bromsgrove High School achieved headline figures in line with national performance at KS4 and slightly below at KS5 in 2018. Our P8 score has moved from -0.64 to -0.25 during a very challenging vear for staff and students.

When you visit North Bromsgrove High School you will find a community of positive students supported by hardworking teachers. You will find a place where the vast majority of students aspire to get the best from their GCSE and post 16 qualifications. You will also sense a desire to see things improve even further and we are working hard to ensure that next year's P8 score is positive. This will be much more likely to happen if we can recruit talented, hardworking, committed practitioners to all of our vacancies.

In joining North Bromsgrove High School you will find a place where talented teachers who go the extra mile for students can shine and develop as practitioners and leaders. Every member of staff here has the potential to be part of a transformation taking place where students' wider experience of school and their outcomes after exams will be excellent.
