



GRADUATE MUSICIAN JOB DESCRIPTION

Job Title: GRADUATE MUSICIAN

Responsible to: Director of Music/Director of Creative Arts

Main Purpose:

To support and enhance the musical life of the school by assisting with teaching, rehearsals, performances, and administrative tasks, while gaining valuable experience in music education and performance.

Roles and Responsibilities:

- Assist with the running of choirs, ensembles, and instrumental rehearsals.
- Support classroom music lessons across various age groups.
- If skillset allows, to provide accompaniment on piano or other instruments for rehearsals and performances.
- Supervise practice sessions and offer guidance to pupils.
- Support the preparation and running of concerts, services, and musical events.
- Contribute to boarding life and co-curricular activities as required (e.g., duties, clubs).
- Assist with music administration, including sheet music, instruments, and performance logistics.
- Participate in school life and model high standards of conduct and professionalism.

Other Duties:

- Undertake any reasonable additional responsibilities as directed by the Director of Music or senior leadership team.
- Support school events and represent the department at open days or public occasions.
- Support other co-curricular activities.
- Be a visible and enthusiastic presence in the school community.
- Play a full and active role in the busy boarding community
- To be a resident tutor in a boarding house of approximately 60 13-18 yr olds including tutoring, supervising and leading activities.
- A proactive approach to engaging with young people is essential

Health and Safety:
