Quality of Education within Mathematics

- In liaison with the Curriculum Leader (Mathematics), continue to adapt the new curriculum to meet the needs of all students; introducing, planning and implementing new courses of study to enable all young people to achieve their personal best.
- Ensure all groups of learners make exceptional progress throughout their time in the Academy, including PP and SEND students.
- In liaison with TLR post holders provide CPD for other members of the team and lead on curriculum development.

Strategic Direction and Development of excellent outcomes within Mathematics

- Contribution to and maintenance of policies and practices which promote high achievement and excellent outcomes for all students from all start points in KS3.
- Creating an environment where students and staff develop and maintain positive attitudes towards teaching and learning.
