Schools requiring Estyn review following Section 28 inspection

As you know, we recently worked with Monmouthshire local authority to review the progress the school has made since the core inspection. Here is a summary of the main discussion points:

- Leadership team has been appropriately strengthened, including through the appointment of an executive headteacher and a range of new appointments to the senior leadership team.
- The school has formed a valuable partnership with another school, which has supported improvements to the quality of teaching and the capacity of leaders to carry out their roles effectively.
- The school has strengthened systems for self-evaluation and improvement planning. As a result, leaders have developed a sharper understanding of the strengths and areas for improvement in their areas of responsibility. This has enabled them to secure improvements and identify key development priorities.
- Levels of accountability have been strengthened suitably, and this is helping to ensure that there is consistency in the effectiveness with which leaders at all levels undertake their role.
- The health and safety issues identified in the core inspection have been addressed appropriately.
