Arts and Design Technology at The Bemrose School

The D&T department is part of the creative faculty. We currently have four experienced specialist teachers delivering Design and Technology, supported by two technicians. The department is housed in a self-contained suite of specialist rooms. These include food, resistant materials, textiles and systems and control rooms.

The department has seen an increase in modern resources over the last few years. These have included CAD/CAM machines for textiles and resistant materials, a suite of computers, a small number of PC's in textiles and a small number of laptops in the food room. A laptop trolley for departmental use is also available.

At KS4 students are able to opt for GCSE design and technology, specialising in either textiles or resistant materials. We also offer a course in hospitality and catering, for students wishing to study food at KS4.

The curriculum at both key stages has undergone significant change over the last few years. This has included innovative new structure for delivering the KS3 curriculum.
