The teaching of Film Studies falls within the Performing Arts Department. KS4 and 5 classes have a dedicated, well-resourced Film Studies room with facilities for making / editing films. Film Studies is an optional subject in KS4 and KS5. KS3 pupils experience modules on film and media in year 8 and year 9 as part of their drama curriculum. At GCSE and A Level, we offer the Eduqas Film Studies specifications which have been delivered successfully for many years at DHFS. We have a very good level of student uptake for courses at KS4 and 5, Film Studies is one of the most popular subjects we offer within the Creative Arts Faculty.

Currently, we have one dedicated full-time member of staff who leads the delivery of Film Studies at KS4 and 5. Due to the on-going popularity of the subject, we are looking to recruit a talented and enthusiastic specialist to support the delivery and development of this exciting subject. We are seeking to employ a committed teacher who has the ability to teach the subject at both GCSE and A Level and who can contribute to the ongoing development of Film and Media within the Creative Arts Faculty. The successful candidate will also be required to teach some Drama at KS3, with the support and guidance of the Drama team. Excellent subject knowledge relating to Film and Media is essential, together with a desire to teach the subject across the age range. The Department works within the wider Creative Arts Faculty and we endeavour to make links across subject disciplines wherever possible. The ability to work closely with other staff as part of a team and the willingness to have an input in developing the curriculum and taking part in extra curricular opportunities is highly desirable.

This position would be suitable for someone at the start of their teaching career or for someone with more experience who is seeking a new challenge.
