Global Academy was founded to tackle the skills shortage and lack of diversity in the UK's media sector.

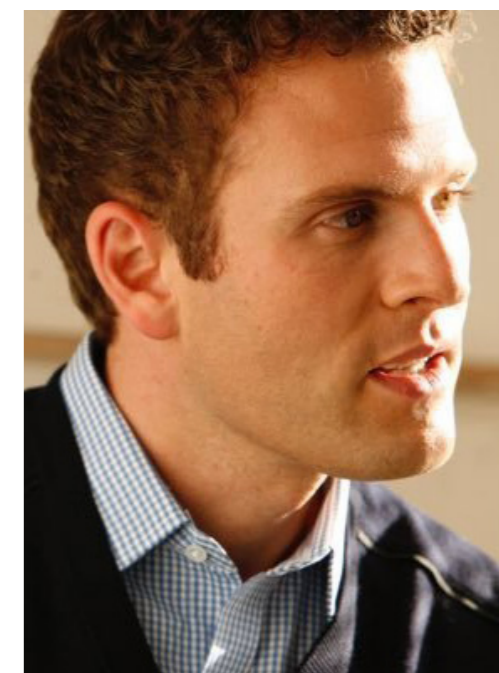
I've always been aware of how difficult it can be to break into the media business – especially for younger people who have the drive yet often lack the practical and technical skills they need.

Study in world-class facilities

Preparing for a long-lasting media career requires access to the best tools in the business. Thanks to substantial investment from our sponsors and partners, Global Academy's innovative, high-tech campus is a learning environment like no other.

Based at The Old Vinyl Factory on the site of EMI's old vinyl record business, our campus boasts industry-standard recording and filming studio spaces, theatres, and a four-storey atrium. From top to the bottom, it was designed from scratch for young people seeking a quality media-focused education.

What's on offer?

Radio Studios

Eight fully equipped radio studios with the latest play-out and broadcast software allow students to produce radio shows and podcasts during media lessons, and also host the academy's award-winning Youths Choice radio station. These studios are often used for broadcasting by Capital, Heart, and LBC, and offer voiceover facilities for commercial clients.

TV Studios

Our larger green screen studio and smaller visual podcast studio help our students create social media content, adverts, music videos, and showreels. Students regularly collaborate with industry professionals on content for companies like Premier League Productions and Global's youth brand Capital Buzz.



Music Production Studios

Our state-of-the-art recording facility and music tech classroom packs in 25 individual Apple Mac workstations with Pro Tools. Our Music Technology department uses these spaces to develop digital productions as well as band recordings, solo track recordings and DJ sessions.



Sports Hall

Physical wellbeing is important for our students, which is why G:Fit lessons take place in our large sports hall. A range of lunchtime and after-school clubs and school teams use the facility, which is also shared with the local community during evenings and weekends.



Edit Suites

Students can book our suites for media projects and developing post-production skills. Each suite contains the latest in Apple technology and is fully soundproofed to create an industry-like working environment. Students have full access to Adobe's Creative Cloud suite, including Premiere Pro and After Effects.



Digital Content Hub & Arts Studios

Our Digital Content Hub is equipped with Adobe Creative Cloud to help students master tools like Photoshop, Illustrator and After Effects. Students can also realise their digital ideas with state-of-the-art large-format and 3D printers. DSLR cameras and lighting softboxes are available for stop-motion projects, while two specialist art and design studios also support 2D creative work.



Computer Rooms

All media classrooms in the school use high powered desktop computers to support learning media production techniques. This ensures students can do everything from making a podcast in Adobe Audition to developing a trailer for their YouTube channel.



Esports Studios

Our world-class esports and gaming studios enable students to compete in tournaments and broadcast globally using cutting-edge streaming equipment. The main studio, featuring top-tier gaming computers, fixed cameras, and LED lighting controls, alongside a supporting content hub, offers everything for live-streamed sports content.



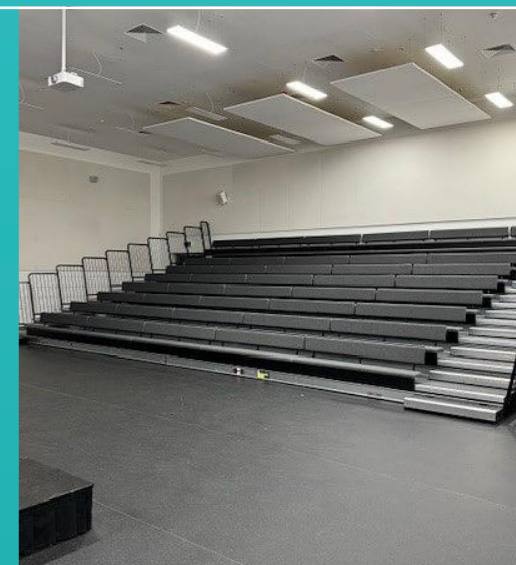
Knowledge Hub

Our brand new Knowledge Hub is the home of Global Academy's collection of fiction and non-fiction books that will inspire and empower our students. For our students, who often come from underrepresented backgrounds, these books are not just educational tools—they are keys to unlocking their potential and opening doors to a brighter future.



Main Hall & Lecture Theatre

Our main hall and lecture theatre host a variety of industry talks and learning experiences. Our theatre is also used annually for end-of-term charity performances, GCSE drama showcases, and multi-school industry workshops. Many commercial clients, including YMCA, Dame Kelly Holmes Trust, Studio Lambert Productions/Channel 4, Hillingdon Council, LBC and GoDaddy have also used this space. The venue is fully equipped with lighting, sound and staging, and offers live-streaming capabilities for assemblies, events and productions.



Visual Podcast Studio

Students can create industry standard visual podcasts in our state of the art podcast studio. Equipped with full studio setup designed to create audio and visual podcasts on demand - with the ability to upload to social media in real time.



Science Lab

Our state-of-the-art science labs give students dedicated space to complete practical experiments as part of GCSE science courses or extracurricular activities in G:Sci, our popular science club. To display their knowledge of science, students often produce digital content in our labs.

While academic, creative, and technical knowledge are of course important, we also provide high standards of care, guidance, and emotional support. Across our campus and beyond, we constantly prioritise the wellbeing and safeguarding of our students.

Our large support team includes four assistant principals, two heads of pastoral care, a SENDCO, a school counselling team, learning support assistants, attendance officer, pastoral administrator and help from external agencies. 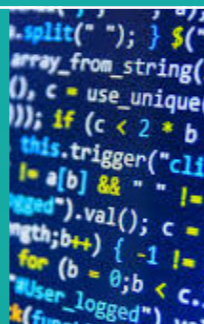
