Set targets for pupil attainment levels;

To provide pupils with opportunities in and out of the classroom for extension and enrichment;

To participate proactively in the department's planning;

Monitor the condition and safe use of classroom equipment and facilities;

To demonstrate good practice in the teaching areas of responsibility;

Participation in personal and whole school Continued Professional Development (CPD) programmes, with a willingness to keep up to date with all training and qualifications, including first aid;
