About Our School

Luckington is a rural school, serving the village of Luckington and the surrounding area. We work closely with Luckington Pre-school, who share our site. Originally a Victorian building, the school has been extended recently to include a modern hall, reception area/library and computer suite. We currently have 45 pupils in 2 classes. There is a high adult: pupil ratio, with 2 full-time teachers, a part time teacher and three TAs. The head teacher also teaches in both classes. The school is at the heart of the local community and benefits from very supportive parents and governors. Pupils are very well-behaved and keen to learn. Their attainment is very good. We are a small, hard-working staff with the highest expectations. We are passionate about teaching and learning and determined to make our curriculum as creative as we can, whilst maintaining the highest standards in core subjects. We link with other small schools in the area for a variety of activities, such as sports tournaments, music festivals and a residential.

Class 2

The Key Stage 2 class currently consists of 31 pupils from Year 3 to Year 6. In the mornings, for maths and English, the class is split into Y3/4 and Y5/6, each with their own teacher. We would like a full time teacher who will teach Y3/4 maths and English in the mornings and Y3/4/5/6 in the afternoons. They need a teacher who can make learning exciting for them, can assess their achievement, understand their individual needs, inspire and challenge them to excel. In return they will show outstanding behaviour and attitude, combined with a willingness to work hard.
