**The Department**

The Department consists of 7 full time teachers and 2 part-time. Drama is taught separately, but at Key Stage 3 is linked closely to the English curriculum. We work closely together as a team and seek a candidate who feels they are able to join this outstanding team of people.



Pupils follow the AQA GCSE English and English Literature courses. All pupils are entered on the higher tier.



Two 'A' Level courses are offered. Pupils follow either the Edexcel English Literature course or the OCR English Language Course.



English is taught in 8 adjacent rooms. At Key Stage 3 pupils follow an agreed series of units of work. However, these are adapted to suit the needs of different groups of pupils. Pupils are taught in mixed ability groups with the six form groups divided into 8 classes.



The Department received extremely positive comments during recent visits by HMI and Ofsted staff.
