

Physical Education Department

The Physical Education department consists of 3 full time staff and a swimming teacher. Facilities include: Sports Hall (which can accommodate most sports including 4 badminton courts, 3 trampolines and a climbing wall), all weather playing surface, a fitness suite, swimming pool, gymnasium and extensive playing fields. The department also has priority use of a classroom in which to teach the theory side of examination courses. The school has a strong tradition in extra curricular sport.

A broad range of activities is taught at Key Stage 3 and 4 in Core PE. The GCSE course follows the Edexcel curriculum and this leads to the BTEC L3 Sport course in Key Stage 5. Summer 2017 results achieved 84% A*-C at GCSE.

Sport is at the heart of Thomas Alleyne's High School and opportunities are available for all abilities. Our very best pupils regularly represent the County and we celebrate our athletes of national acclaim. Extra curricular activities and regular fixtures are therefore an important aspect of the department.
