Key Responsibilities

- Carry out the professional duties of a School Teacher as set out in the national School Teachers' Pay and Conditions Document (revised annually)
- Teach pupils of all ages and abilities from Y7 to Y11
- Teach across a wide range of activities offered at KS3 and KS4
- Contribute towards developing GCSE programmes offered to all pupils in KS4
- Contribute to and support extra-curricular activities
- Act as a form tutor for allocated pupils to promote the partnership between the home and the school through regular contact/meetings with parents/carers and students
- Support the development of teaching and learning within the department
- Take part with in service training and be responsible for own personal development
- Contribute to and support school policies and procedures
- Play an active role in carrying out and supporting classroom management procedures and school policy on behaviour
- Contribute to raising the achievements, attainment and aspirations of all pupils
- Attend relevant staff and department meetings
- Act as an appropriate role model for pupils
- Promote and safeguard the welfare of learners and young people
- Undertake any other duties initiated by the Principal or Vice Principals.
