Responsibilities

In consultation with the Precentor and Head of Instrumental Music:

- Plan and assist with the continued development of music, which may include the coaching of bands and ensembles, supervising live recordings, studio and production work.
- Supervise 6th Form Curriculum Extension Projects and develop opportunities for extension work in composition, music technology and other areas for other year groups.
- Work with a team of Visiting Music Teachers to run the weekly bands night.
- Plan and assist with a range of performing opportunities, a programme of events and external visits.
- Foster links with other establishments and professional musicians.
- Stay informed about and advise on appropriate tertiary courses, summer courses, masterclasses, assessments (exams) and other opportunities.

Department General

- To assist with additional coaching and accompanying including:
 - Composition and performance coursework
 - Aural tests
 - Competitions
 - Concerts, stage musicals.
- Other accompanying and coaching as required.
- To assist with the organisation of concerts, tours, trips and other major events.
- To assist with the support and mentoring of music scholars.
- To attend departmental meetings.
- To assist with the arrangement and transposition of parts or scores as required for ensembles and instrumental lessons.
- To oversee the ordering and hiring of music for large ensembles.
