Duties

The duties outlined in this job description are in addition to those covered by the latest School Teachers' Pay and Conditions Document. It may be modified by a line manager, with your agreement, to reflect or anticipate changes in the job, commensurate with the salary and job title.

Teaching and learning

1. Carry out teaching duties in accordance with the academy's patterns of working, schemes of work, the National Curriculum and the requirements of line managers.
2. Liaise with colleagues to deliver units of work in a collaborative manner.
3. Work with teaching assistants and the SENCO.
4. Set targets for student attainment levels.
5. Set work for students absent from academy.
6. Demonstrate good practice in the teaching areas of responsibility.

Assessing and reporting

1. Record students' work.
2. Maintain lesson evaluations.
3. Mark and return work within agreed time span, providing diagnostic feedback and next step targets.
4. Provide assessment reports to monitor student progress as required.
5. Liaise with parents and attend consultation events.
6. Work within the Code of Practice relating to Special Educational Needs.

General

- Work in conjunction with the Head of Department to develop coherent and effective schemes of work and medium term plans for the subject area.
- Co-develop teaching and learning resources.
- Contribute to transition liaison programmes as required.
- Act in the capacity of a form tutor as required.
- Contribute to duty and other support teams as required.

Other duties and responsibilities

Any other tasks that line managers may make reasonable request of the post-holder to perform.
