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## PRIMARY TASK

- Assist in the implementation of Individual Education Programmes for students and help monitor their progress
- Provide support for individual students inside and outside the classroom to enable them to fully participate in activities
- Work with other professionals, such as Management Team within The Amicus Community, Therapeutic Care Workers, Local Authorities and CAMHS Teams
- Support students with emotional or behavioural problems and help develop their social skills
- Assist class teacher with maintaining student records
- Prepare and present displays of students' work
- Support class teacher in photocopying and other tasks in order to support teaching
- Undertake other duties from time to time as the Head Teacher requires
- Support the aims and ethos of the school
- Set a good example in terms of dress, punctuality and attendance
- Attend team and staff meetings
- Undertake professional duties that may be reasonably assigned by the Head Teacher
- Be proactive in matters relating to health and safety
- Attend ongoing and regular supervision
- Ensure you work to the best practice in the protection and safeguarding of the children
