A love of language.

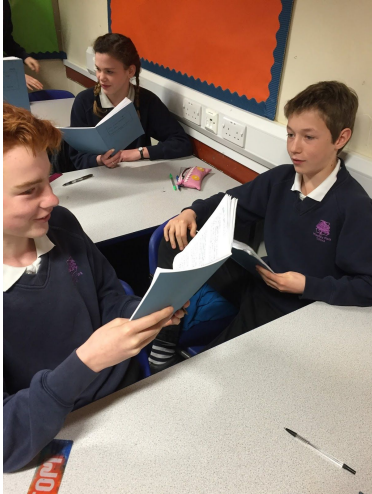
- A high proportion of students study at least one language to GCSE level.
