Founded in 1929, The John Fisher School is a Catholic secondary school which currently caters for over 1,100 boys (to include over 225 in the Sixth Form). Serving the educational needs of the community of Purley and neighbouring areas, The John Fisher School identifies as a centre of learning and wellbeing.

In 2022, 27% of the school's GCSE grades were a 9-7/A*-A grade. 85% of students secured a Level 4 or above in Maths and 89% of students gained at least a Level 4 in English Language or English Literature. 82% of students achieved at least a Level 4 in 5 or more GCSEs including English and Maths. At A Level, 35% of grades were A*- A and 55% were A*- B.

In our previous graded inspection, 'Behaviour and Safety' and our Sixth Form were judged 'outstanding'. In our most recent monitoring visit (April 2022), Ofsted stated that *'this is a caring community, where all pupils are welcomed and included in the Fisher Family. The work of leaders and staff is guided by shared values, centred on dignity and respect for the individual. These values provide a unifying thread for all aspects of school life.'*

We are currently looking to employ a Chaplain to support the school community in furthering the distinctive Christian character of its status and in the provision of pastoral care. This post could potentially suit a former Theology student.
