Purpose of Job

To work within the IT support team to help the smooth running of all aspects of the computer network, providing first and second line support to staff and students of the school.

Main Duties

- Diagnosing and resolving technical issues
- Escalating IT issues to the IT Services Manager where necessary
- Setting up and configuring new laptops and desktops
- Installing authorised software
- Creating and administering user accounts
- Maintain IT hardware (Laptops, desktops and peripherals) as directed by the IT Services Manager.
- Installing printer consumables such as toner cartridges, fusers etc.
- Carry out daily ICT suite checks, checking PCs are switched on and working at the beginning of the day.
- Security marking and maintaining an inventory of equipment.
- Assisting the IT support team to deliver a first class service to the school community.
- Assistance with Tablets, Cameras, etc.
- Provide simple training to staff or students on standard computer applications.
- Participate in the school appraisal scheme for support staff.
- Take on additional responsibilities delegated by the IT Services Manager.

Training

• Throughout the Level 3 apprenticeship you will be expected to attend Peterborough Regional College on release for structured training.

Person Specification

Applicants will be judged against the following criteria:

Essential

- Having good communication skills, written and verbal.
- Being able to explain technical issues to non-technical users.
- Must work well in a team but still have the ability to work independently.
- Having an understanding of the following technologies:
 - Windows Desktop Operating Systems such as Windows 10 Professional.
 - o Microsoft Office applications.
- Being able to work well under periods of pressure.
- Possessing excellent problem-solving abilities.
- Having an understanding of a 'customer focused' mind-set.
- Having a strong willingness to learn.
- Proactivity and ability and confidence to use own initiative.
- Possessing an eye for quality and high standards of work.
- Having the commitment and willingness to combine work with study through the apprenticeship by attending the Peterborough Regional College throughout the deployment.
- Having been awarded a minimum of five GCSEs at grade 'C' and above Including Maths, English and ICT (or equivalents).
- Have the ability to fulfil all spoken aspects of the role with confidence through the medium of English.

Desirable

- Previous experience in a technical support environment would be an advantage.
- Previous experience of working with children or young people would be of benefit.

The above desirable criteria are not prerequisites, as full training will be provided.



Pay and Conditions of Service

The successful applicants will be employed for 37 hours per week, 52 weeks per year.

Salary will be paid at the National Minimum Wage for Apprentices.

If you are appointed to the post, it will be on the understanding that you are prepared to undergo an Enhanced DBS check and if necessary, a medical examination.
