Role Profile: Music Teacher

Purpose

To teach Music across Year 3 to Year 8 and co-ordinate the Peripatetic Instrumental Teachers.

Key Accountabilities (6-8 max)

- To deliver Music lesson to pupils from Years 3 to 5. Direct Instrumental ensembles and Choirs in Years 3 and 4.
- To co-ordinate the timetabling and invoicing of the Instrumental Teachers as directed by the Head of Music on a weekly basis.
- To accompany the Whole school singing in assemblies on the piano, being able to accompany pupils in concerts where necessary. (First- study pianist sought for this role)
- In conjunction with the Head of Music and the Music teaching team; to plan and prepare relevant material to teach classes and prepare pupils for concerts including rehearsal-scheduling where necessary.
- Set targets for pupils, record marks, monitor and assess progress and write reports as required.
- Share in supervisory and general duties; uphold good standards of behaviour and punctuality among pupils.
