

TEACHER OF ENGLISH, part-time (approx. 0.6FTE, days tbc), fixed term contract to July 2018

We are looking for an inspirational teacher with strong academic credentials, for part-time (approx. 0.6FTE) teaching in the English department, starting either in November 2017 or January 2018. This is a fixed-term contract, lasting through to July 2018.

The successful applicant will be:

- A dynamic classroom practitioner, able to teach KS3 successfully, including the teaching of spelling, punctuation and grammar
- A warm and effective communicator, committed to ensuring that all pupils make excellent progress.

The English Department currently consists of the Head of Department and four other specialist teachers. It is housed largely in its own dedicated suite of classrooms, all of which are equipped with interactive whiteboards. There is also a departmental office/resource room.

In the first three years, English is taught in form groups of approximately 20-22 students. The Department has its own flexible Key Stage 3 English Programme, which is subject to continuous review and development.
