JOB ROLE

This exciting new role will act as a leading practitioner in the development and delivery of adult and community learning, developing and maintaining relationships with key stakeholders to support residents to access provision and progress to further education and employment.

This role will be pivotal in the design of the curriculum offer, working with a range of curriculum teams to create an agile, responsive offer that ensures recruitment targets are achieved. This role will involve building and maximising community relationships to promote learning opportunities, progression and employment, fostering positive learning environments that encourage and enable learners to develop skills and creating a community environment at the Learning & Skills Centre in Cradley Heath.

Working collaboratively with the wider College teams, the postholder will raise the profile of the College's adult provision and promote the wide range of opportunities available across College sites. Working with key stakeholders including Sandwell Local Authority, West Midlands Combined Authority and the DWP the role will develop relationships that increase engagement and demonstrate the impact the College is having in delivering on local, regional and national priorities.

1.	Promote the wide range of opportunities for adults across the Sandwell Colleges to a range of potential student cohorts and groups.	
2.	Act as an ambassador for adult provision actively engaging with community, faith and other leaders to secure adult learners to the Colleges.	
3.	Working alongside the Head of Adult & Community Learning Campus Lead and other key senior managers create an Adult & Community board for Cradley that brings key stakeholders together to create meaningful partnerships that deliver solutions to local challenges	
4.	Support in planning, preparation, and delivery of adult provision ensuring that the curriculum meets the appropriate standards and is accessible to diverse learner groups	
5.	Meet regularly with key operational staff at Sandwell Local Authority, West Midlands Combined Authority and the DWP to develop and maintain referral pathways and report on activities against set performance measures	



6.	Participate in curriculum development, planning and implementation whilst maintaining up-to-date knowledge of best practice, curriculum developments and relevant legislative requirements.	
7.	Work alongside marketing and communications colleagues to develop materials to engage communities and promote the Colleges offer	
8.	Produce weekly and monthly reports detailing meetings attended and performance against a set of recruitment and progression targets.	
9.	Contribute to the continuous improvement of adult programs through learner, employer and partner feedback	
10.	Monitor and record learner attendance, achievements, and progress in line with College systems and processes.	
11.	Organise and coordinate community events that attract people to College provision, demonstrating our offer and breaking down barriers to education	
12.	Provide initial pastoral support for students facing challenges, supporting them to access College resources and retaining in education	
13.	Assist in the development and delivery of a range of effective support for learners.	
14.	Organise and take part in residential, educational trips and visits and enrichment activities to enhance the student experience	
15.	Ensure effective communication with all colleagues and learners and collaborate with colleagues and external partners to support learner progression and integration.	
16.	Ensure a high level of confidentiality at all times	
17.	Participate in staff meetings, training, and professional development activities	
18.	Teaching hours agreed by line manager	
19.	Commit to, promote and operate in accordance with the college's values and goals including but not limited to: safeguarding and prevent; health and safety; equality, diversity and inclusion.
