Many thanks for your interest in the post of Teacher of Mathematics at Brookfield. The post arises due to the retirement of the current post-holder. This represents an opportunity for either an NQT or an experienced teacher to join a highly successful and hardworking team of Mathematics staff who have consistently achieved results well above the national average at GCSE and Post 16.

We are seeking a candidate who will:

- Build on the excellent spirit of teamwork in the faculty.
- Improve further the good progress, achievement and excellent examination outcomes in Mathematics.
- Maintain a clear vision for teaching and learning and a focus on the needs of the individual student.

In Year 7 Mathematics is taught to all ability form groups. In Years 8, 9, 10 and 11 students are taught in settled groups based on ability. Most students work towards GCSE at the higher level.

Mathematics is a very popular subject at A Level. A small but significant number of students study Further Mathematics. Graphical/programmable calculators are used extensively in A Level lessons.

The department has ten subject specialists and there is some input from other colleagues. All department members teach a range of Key Stage 3, Key Stage 4 and Key Stage 5 groups. In addition to the Head of Department there are three other posts Key Stage 3 Co-ordinator, Key Stage 4 Co-ordinator and Post-16 Co-ordinator.

The department is located within an area comprising six rooms in the main block, with an additional room in the sixth form block. Inevitably at times some groups cannot be accommodated and have to be taught elsewhere in the school. There is a departmental office suitable for all staff to work comfortably within the Mathematics area and the department is well resourced. All classrooms have interactive whiteboards.

The post will appeal to an energetic, enthusiastic teacher who is keen to work in a school which has its sights firmly set on providing quality education for all students. Candidates are encouraged to explain what particular skills, interest or experience they would bring to the post.

We would ask much of the successful candidate. Equally we feel that, as a school, we have a lot to offer.
