

## JOB DESCRIPTION

## This school is committed to safeguarding and promoting the wellbeing of children and young people and expects all staff and volunteers to share this commitment

**Post Title:** Teaching Assistant

**Grade:** Level 2 scale 4-5

**Responsible to:** Principal

**Purpose of the Job:** Support the classroom teacher to facilitate the active participation of children in

the academic and social activities of the school. Contribute to raising standards

of achievement for all pupils.

## Main Duties and Responsibilities:

1. Under the direction of the class teacher, supervise the class in following a programme of study.

- 2. Provide specialist learning support (requiring in-depth knowledge and experience) to children with severe special needs, or where English is not their first language
- 3. Take responsibility for delivering learning activities with groups who would benefit from a different learning approach as agreed with the class teacher.
- 4. Establish and maintain supportive relationships with individual pupils, small groups and parents/carers to ensure they understand and can achieve the tasks.
- 5. Liaise with specialist services on behalf of individual pupils, e.g. educational psychologists, speech therapists, by agreement with the class teacher.
- 6. Encourage and promote inclusion in the classroom, ensuring all pupils feel involved with tasks and activities.
- 7. To monitor the behaviour of pupils discouraging in a positive way any anti-social behaviour and reporting any incidents to the teacher, senior leaders, as appropriate.
- 8. To ensure the safety and well being of children, providing emotional support where necessary.
- 9. To ensure that all pupils who suffer any injury or accident are dealt with appropriately in accordance with the school's agreed procedures.
- 10. Support the school curriculum, including literacy and numeracy activities.
- 11. Provide additional tuition for children who need extra support with ICT.
- 12. Arrange and deliver special classes for pupils to improve the range or quality of subjects offered as agreed.
- 13. Provide targeted support to enhance learning and improve attainment
- 14. Contribute to reports on pupil progress and development against National Curriculum descriptors.
- 15. Contribute to the development of IEPs for children with special needs.
- 16. Contribute to the planning and evaluation of work programmes for individual pupils and groups.
- 17. Provide feedback on learning activities and contribute to school review and development planning.
- 18. Organise the learning environment and develop appropriate classroom resources as required.
- 19. Contribute to behaviour management within the school and take charge of situations to allow the teacher to continue to work with the rest of the class.



- 20. Develop and maintain effective working relationships with other staff and parents or carers.
- 21. Contribute to the maintenance of a safe and healthy environment.
- 22. Attend and actively participate in staff meetings.
- 23. Contribute to the development of less experienced teaching assistants
- 24. Act as a mentor for less experienced teaching assistants on best practice and methods of overcoming difficulties.
- 25. Make suggestions for school events and take a leading role in organising them as agreed.
