- 1.9 Prepare learners for a range of accreditation and assessments
- 1.10 Maintain accurate and detailed student records, including the writing of reports and references.
- 1.11 Set and monitor Personal Targets and elLPs according to Faculty and College Policy.
- 1.12 Participate in open evenings, recruitment, trade events, conferences and other marketing events.
