4	Challenge students to THINK They use resources INDEPENDENTLY to solve problems.				
5	Respond to student FEEDBACK. Be ready to change and adapt the lesson if necessary.				
6	Help students make CONNECTIONS to PRIOR LEARNING so they see the BIG PICTURE and move forward.				
7	Give CLEAR instructions and model what you want to see.				
8	QUESTIONS develop a TWO WAY FLOW that encourage students to THINK.				
9	EVERYONE WILL MOVE RAPIDLY towards their TARGET. NO students will be left behind and no one will be held back.				
10	Students will ENJOY learning.
