The Politics, Business, Economics and Law Section incorporates A Level Politics, Economics, Law and Business, in addition to vocational programmes such as Applied Law. The Section provides a rich and varied curriculum and has achieved outstanding results. There is an ethos of developing its teaching and learning approach to incorporate active teaching and differentiation to further strengthen the success rates already achieved.

The Section offers a significant enrichment programme including the Peter Jones' Tycoon competition, the Micro Tyco Social Enterprise challenge, a variety of events run by the Chartered Institute of Accounts for England and Wales, the Royal Economic Society's Young Economist of the Year competition, and the Mock Trial competition. In addition to this, a number of visits are arranged to places such as the Magistrates Court and a variety of businesses.

The Section is well resourced with a suite of classrooms and ICT rooms to support teaching and learning. In addition, the Section provides high levels of one to one support outside of the classroom, including revision seminars during the lunchtimes and holidays. The Section is focused on helping students to gain places at the preferred destinations. Therefore, students are provided with support with applying for places on college-leavers programmes with market-leading firms as well as assistance with applying for university.
