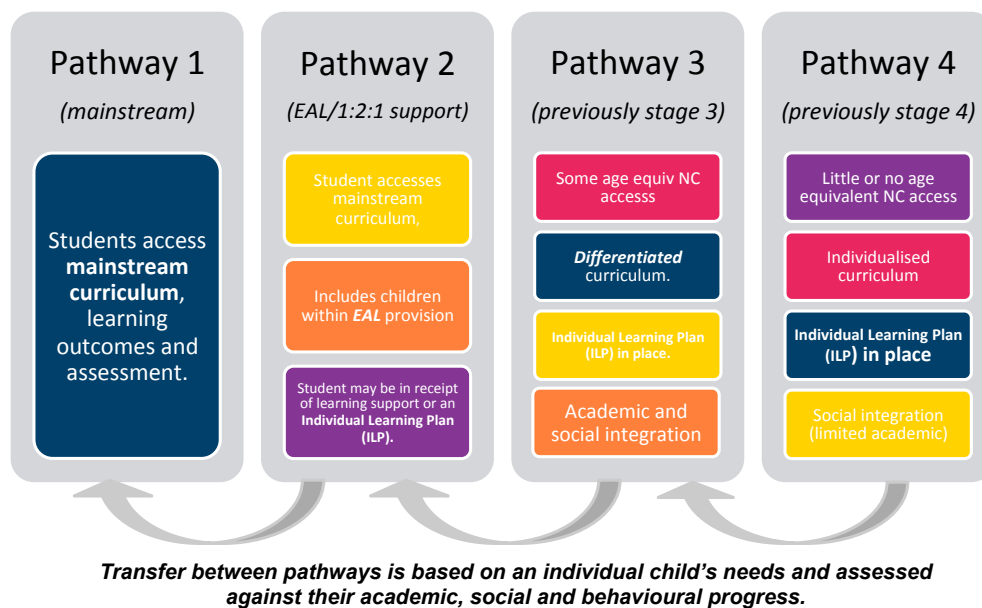


Teaching SEN at Dover Court
