

KTC Dress Code Policy

The female dress code is:

- Skirts must be long enough to cover the knee, whilst sitting.
- Splits in skirts must be no higher than knee level.
- Skirts, blouses, tee shirts etc must not be very tight and/or transparent.
- Necklines must not be lower than the collarbone.
- Your torso must be covered - this also applies when raising your arms.
- Sleeves must cover the elbow.
- Any printing on clothing must be appropriate.
- No pants or footless/three-quarter tights are to be worn under skirts.
- Married Jewish Studies staff must have their heads fully covered with no visible hair showing and legs fully covered at all times.

The male dress code is:

- Long trousers, no jeans.
- Dress shirts and tie
- Any printing on clothing must be appropriate.

Professional Footwear:

Staff must wear professional footwear addressing OH&S standards. This means shoes must have a closed toe. For the avoidance of doubt, unacceptable footwear includes Birkenstocks, Crocs, Uggs, strappy sandals and thongs.
