Job Description

Teachers receiving Teaching and Learning Responsibility Payments provide professional leadership and management for their school/subject areas(s) to secure high quality teaching, effective use of resources and improved standards of learning and achievement for all students. They are accountable for a significant, specified responsibility focused on teaching and learning, that is not required of all classroom teachers.

All staff are ultimately responsible to the Principal. Your immediate responsibility is to the Subject Leader.

Job Purpose

To support the Subject Leader in:

- strategically leading the work of the department to ensure high standards and achievement in KS4 English.
- promoting the aims, objectives, ethos and public image of the department
- establishing the highest standards of attainment, attendance, behaviour and commitment for all students in KS4 English in liaison with the Heads of Year and Achievement Leaders
- ensuring effective and personalised support for learning for KS4 students
- eliciting the support of all parents and carers as active partners in children's learning
- monitoring student progress and planning effective interventions where appropriate
- support teacher development across the department



Responsibilities

The KS4 English Co-ordinator will:

- be able to teach across the full range of ages and abilities
- act as a role model in leading staff in own high quality teaching
- assist the Subject Leader in developing Assessment for Learning throughout KS4 English lessons
- set high expectations for staff and students in relation to standards of achievement and the quality of teaching
- be as visible and accessible as possible throughout the school day to provide encouragement and support for students' learning and an ongoing focus on the academy's ethos and expectations
- support the Subject Leader in creating, implementing and improving Schemes of Work which encapsulate the academy learning strategies and educational developments
- develop and implement strategies that enable KS4 students to become more effective learners
- support the Subject Leader in developing and implementing intervention and support strategies that help to eliminate under-achievement by individual students
- promote and celebrate the achievements of all students within the department
- promote the use of positive behaviour management strategies that directly support effective teaching, learning and discipline and take responsibility for maintaining positive behaviour within the department
- assist the Subject Leader in identifying students who are underachieving and, where necessary, aid the creation and implementation of effective intervention plans
- support the Subject Leader in establishing and implementing clear policies and practices for assessing, recording and reporting on student achievement and to assist students in setting targets for further improvement
- assist the Subject Leader in evaluating the standards of teaching and learning in line with the procedures in the Academy self evaluation policy and use this analysis to take action to improve further the quality of teaching
- promote extra-curricular activity and engagement
- support the Academy's commitment to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children.
- undertake any other task reasonably requested by the Principal



Generic/Teachers

All teachers are expected to:

- Carry out duties of a school teacher as set out in the Pay and conditions Document and subject to any amendments due to Government legislation. This includes any duties as may be reasonably directed by the Principal.
- Uphold the academy's principles and policies which underpin good practice and the raising of standards.
- Demonstrate a thorough and up to date knowledge of the teaching of your subject and take account of wider curriculum developments which are relevant to your work.
- Consistently and effectively plan lessons and sequences of lessons to meet students' individual learning needs.
- Consistently and effectively use information about prior attainment to set wellgrounded expectations for pupils and monitor progress to give clear and constructive feedback.
- Demonstrate that, as a result of your teaching, your students achieve well, relative to the students' prior attainment.
- Take responsibility for your professional development and use the outcomes to improve your teaching and students' learning.
- Make an active contribution to the policies and aspirations of the academy.
