The department currently comprises three full time Geography staff and is situated in four classrooms, with all rooms benefiting from projectors and interactive whiteboards.

Geography is a popular and successful subject in the school, and attracts a large number of pupils and students at GCSE, A Level. The department follows the AQA specification at GCSE and Edexcel at A level.

At Key Stage 3 we have a dynamic programme of study that engages pupils of all abilities and interest areas, and prepares them well for their continuing studies at KS4 and beyond. The Geography department has built a wide and varied range of resources and teaching materials to help support pupil progress, as well as to enable enquiry based learning.

Both A-Level and GCSE courses incorporate a fieldwork element and this is seen as an integral part of students' learning experience outside of the classroom.
