The successful candidate for this role will have strong interpersonal skills and be motivated by the prospect of supporting these students by supervising them in large numbers, whilst also being on hand to complete administrative tasks to support the smooth running of the school.

We require a committed team player who is excited by the prospect of working in a busy and ambitious environment to contribute to the success of one of the country's leading Sixth Forms. Study Centre supervisors typically rotate between two shifts (8.00am - 3.42pm and 10.18am - 6pm) and are occasionally required outside of these hours to support calendared Sixth Form events, such as Open Evenings.
