Mathematics Curriculum Area

The Mathematics Area comprises an enthusiastic, supportive and collaborative group of nine teachers, committed to providing the best experience and opportunities for all of our students. We work together to address school based priorities but have a strong sense of our own identity and a clear direction too.

In Key Stage 3, we teach seven one hour lessons per fortnight to our Year 7 and Year 8 students, who are set. Our Key Stage 4 students all have eight hours of Maths a fortnight. At Key Stage 4 we have four higher sets and three foundation sets. Our lower sets are smaller to facilitate more individualised, targeted teaching. At Key Stage 5 we offer A Level Maths and Further Maths, both of which have eight hours of lessons a fortnight.

As a curriculum area, we have enthusiastically embraced the challenges of the new GCSEs and have schemes of work for each unit. Our Key Stage 3 schemes provide a varied and enjoyable curriculum with clear routes for progress, but with the flexibility to adapt to individual teachers' and classes' needs. We treat Year 9 as the first year of GCSE.

Our aspiration is that every child leaves our classrooms with a love of Mathematics and the resilience to solve a problem. We are well resourced and all of our teaching rooms have electronic projectors and interactive whiteboards. We have invested heavily in software to support our teaching.

We have a strong team ethos and believe in working collaboratively, sharing ideas and supporting each other to achieve great things and see this as the key to further developing effective teaching and learning strategies.
