This is a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity to join the founding team of teachers as a we build a world-leading school with the support of a world-class education group in one of the world's most exciting cities.

DCBK combines a rich heritage of British international education with Thai values and culture, initially catering to Early Years and Junior/Prep School students, we plan to expand to 1,800 students following the opening of the Senior School in 2029.

The College will provide an exceptional educational experience, emphasizing academic excellence, holistic development, and the Dulwich ethos. We offer a premium international education built on our unique British-style curriculum, enhanced and enriched to accommodate students from Nursery through to Year 13. Academic achievement will be supplemented by a rich tapestry of extracurricular activities and state-of-the-art educational resources. Moreover, the school's ethos of holistic development ensures that our students emerge as well-rounded individuals, prepared to navigate an ever-evolving global landscape.

As part of the founding team, you will play a pivotal role in shaping a school culture rooted in academic excellence, creativity, and global citizenship – enabling our students to Live Worldwise.









OUR CAMPUS DESIGN

The campus design for Dulwich College Bangkok creates an environment that seamlessly blends traditional Dulwich College architecture, Thai signature elements, and contemporary design within a spacious, green setting. The campus features low-rise, human scale buildings that evoke a sense of place and belonging for our students. You can see a flythrough here.

Our school campus is being built in phases and we are currently accepting student admissions for Nursery to Year 7 in August 2026. In Phase One we are building our two teaching clusters (one for DUCKS, aged 3 to 7 and one for our Junior/Prep children, aged 7+). Phase One also includes our Village Centre and our Sports Complex (housing our indoor 50m pool, a learner pool, three basketball courts and a performance space).













OUR CAMPUS DESIGN

In August 2029, Phase Two is due to open, which will include our Senior School teaching spaces and our Performing Arts Centre, a Thai interpretation of Shakespeare's Globe Theatre, reflecting Dulwich College's English heritage and commitment to excellence in the Arts.

The College is set within a natural, tropical landscape, aligning with Education in Motion's strong focus on outdoor learning, and creating a Dulwich Village-style campus inspired by traditional Thai villages. The Village Centre will act as the community's focal point, embodying the concept that "it takes a village to educate a child." You can learn more here.

Sustainability is a key focus, with the goal of becoming one of Thailand's first international schools to achieve LEED Gold certification for green building design and WELL Gold certification for promoting health and well-being. Indoor air quality will be enhanced by air filtration systems, ensuring purified fresh air throughout the year.

Dining facilities will feature an open-plan concept with live cooking stations. Spacious classroom sizes will support inquiry-based and project-based learning models in the Primary School. The campus will also incorporate cutting edge technology throughout, with flexible indoor and outdoor learning spaces.









EDUCATION IN MOTION


