



THE PERSE SCHOOL SINGAPORE

The Perse School (Singapore) will provide high quality education for children aged 6 to 12, primarily based around Cambridge Assessment International Education qualifications. It is envisaged that, once at capacity, the school will educate approximately 500 pupils, boys and girls.

The location of the school is in the Bukit Timah district, adjacent to the nature reserve, in a smart residential and commercial area approximately 14km from the central business district. The building itself allows the creation of vibrant and interesting classrooms as the structure of the building is based around large, open internal spaces.
